



Luella Scott Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility:

Applicant must be an African-American female graduating high school senior with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale.

Requirements:

A completed electronic application

A 500-word autobiography

A 500-word essay addressing why this scholarship is needed

A small photo uploaded as a jpeg to the electronic application

An electronic signature for media release on the electronic application

An official transcript in a sealed envelope

Two (2) signed letters of recommendation in separate envelopes

These must be on official letterhead with a physical signature. One letter must be from a school official and the other must be from a community leader

- **Proof of enrollment must be provided with a letter from the registrar and a letter of acceptance from the institution. This information must be furnished no more than one week after the first day of classes so that the scholarship money may be sent to the school.**
- **The recipient must provide the school's complete name (to be used as the payee), the correct mailing address, and the student's ID number. If the institution requires any special forms to be completed, those should be provided as well.**



The following shall be grounds for losing the scholarship:

- a college GPA below 3.0 during the academic year
- failure to maintain at least 12 credit hours during the academic year
- failure to maintain full-time status during the academic year
- violation of the Code of Student Conduct of the institution of attendance
- violation of any local, state, and/or federal law(s)
- pregnancy without marriage

Note: This is a ONE-TIME scholarship paid in two equal payments of one per semester.
